

Home Park Community Clean Up on 1/23/2010

- 168 man-hours from Midtown Blue which includes 21 community service workers, 7 employees, 4 pick up trucks and 3 APD officers
- 7 tons of trash, 341 fifty gallon garbage bags, and two dumpster loads of limbs (waiting for the city to pick up)
- 17 sewer drains were unstopped
- 4 cars were impounded
- 4 TV stations covered the clean up
- Approximately 80 to 100 people attended and most participated directly in the clean up effort.
- Two City Council members spoke (Kwanza Hall bought 50 sub sandwiches); Senator Fort attended.
- Residents were quite pleased with the effort, partnership with GA Tech, a focus on cleaning up the community, etc.
- Various partners provided food/drink: Coca-Cola, Papa John's, Antico Pizza, APD (Krispy Kreme donuts), Toscano & Sons Italian Market, Atlantic Station Target (water).
- 10th St. United Methodist Church was a great host; the location was perfect.
- Bright Futures Atlanta Academy's high school volunteers were wonderful, along with their bus transporting the municipal workers (despite the bus breaking down at the church).
